Programs & Services Offered

- Therapeutic Visitation
- Child Counseling
- Supervised Visitation
- Monitored Custody Exchanges
- Child Play Therapy

Supervised Visitation

Provides the children of divided families with access to their non-custodial parent in a neutral, safe, supportive, and homelike environment

Child Counseling

Provides children with counseling for behavioral and emotional problems in a safe and supportive environment.

Therapeutic Visitation

Provides parents and children with the completion of therapeutic goals that can include healing of past trauma, communication of feelings, and provide the parents with a better understanding of the child's needs.

Monitored Custody Exchanges

Exchanges are made in a safe and neutral environment at pre-arranged times that can be staggered so parents will not be in contact with one another. Times are offered seven days a week, with day and evening times available.

Child Play Therapy

Assists children who have experienced severe trauma in communicating through non-verbal means such as art and play.

How to

Get Started

1. Both parties need to call, schedule, and complete an intake before visits can start.
2. Parties need to bring picture ID and a copy of the court order (if applicable to the intake).
3. After intake, the Children's Center will contact both parties to schedule a set day and time for visits.
